




HIV/AIDS in North Carolina¹ April 2018


HIV in North Carolina, by the most recent numbers.

- 29,814: the number of North Carolinians living with diagnosed HIV/AIDS in 2015.
- 6th: in the nation for the number of new HIV diagnoses in 2016.
- 1,404 people were newly diagnosed with HIV in North Carolina in 2016 alone.
- 61.5% of North Carolinians diagnosed with HIV in 2016 were between the ages of 13 & 34.
