HIV IN LOUISIANA, BY THE NUMBERS¹



20,085: the number of Louisianans living with diagnosed HIV in 2016.



4th in the nation: in HIV diagnosis rates in 2017.



4th in the nation: in HIV death rates in 2016.



6th in the nation: in HIV prevalence rates in 2016.



- An estimated 12,608 Louisianans received services through Ryan
- White in 2015.
- 64.8% were living at or below the poverty line.
- Since Ryan White is legally required to be the "payer of last resort,"
- these people did not have other access to medical or support
- services.



• \$17.38 million went to the AIDS Drug Assistance Program(ADAP).

RYAN WHITE IS CRUCIAL FOR LOUISIANA

- Over the past five years, annual funding decreased by 8%.
- The **Ending HIV Epidemic: Plan for America** would increase funding to East Baton Rouge Parish and Orleans Parish.



RYAN WHITE WORKS!



Ryan White services keep HIV-positive individuals in treatment and care



With treatment, people with HIV can live active, healthy lives.



People whose virus is suppressed for 6 months cannot transmit HIV through sex.





But, if disconnected from care, resistance to medications can develop making it easier to transmit HIV.

Moreover, without treatment HIV is deadly. ⁵

While only 60% of people nationwide have a viral load that is effectively suppressed as of 2014,6

of HIV-positive clients who had received at least one Ryan White funded medical care visit have achieved viral suppression.⁷
